


Figure 1: location of Greenham and Crookham Commons and the extent of the survey area (scale at 1: 25,000)



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Figure 2: Greenham and Crookham Commons Site of Special Scientific Interest (scale at 1: 25,000)




Figure 3: Management Plan Compartments

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




Figure 4: Higher Level Stewardship environmental types (scale at 1 to 12500)




Figure 5: key to the survey plans















Figure 11: extract from John Rocque's map of Berkshire, 1761

Figure 12: extract from a plan of the manor of Chamberhouse, 1768




Figure 13: extract from a survey of the estate at Sandleford, 1781




Figure 14: extract from the Greenham tithe map to show part of the southern boundary of the common and encroachments to the north of Peckmoor Copse, 1840







Figure 15: extract from the Greenham tithe map to show part of the southern boundary of the common in Clarke's Gully and encroachments near Balls Hill, 1840

Figure 18: extract from the Thatcham tithe map to show part of the southern boundary of Crookham Common and encroachments around Foxhold Farm, 1840




Figure 19: extract from the Thatcham tithe map to show part of the southern boundary of Crookham Common and encroachments in the Boar's Gully area, 1840




Figure 20: extract from the Thatcham tithe map to show boundaries and encroachments towards the eastern end of Crookham Common, 1840




Figure 21: extract from the six inch first edition Ordnance Survey map to show Greenham Common and the western part of Crookham Common, 1874 (survey boundary shown in bold)




Figure 22: extract from the six inch first edition Ordnance Survey map to show the eastern part of Crookham Common, 1874 (survey boundary shown in bold)




Figure 23: extract from the six inch second edition Ordnance Survey map to show the southern part of Greenham Common and the south-western end of Crookham Common, 1898



Figure 24: extract from the six inch second edition Ordnance Survey map to show the northern part of Greenham Common and the north-western end of Crookham Common, 1898




Figure 25: extract from the six inch second edition Ordnance Survey map to show part of the southern margins of Crookham Common, 1898




Figure 26: extract from the six inch second edition Ordnance Survey map to show the northern and eastern parts of Crookham Common, 1898




Figure 27: extract from the six inch third edition Ordnance Survey map to show the southern part of Greenham Common and the south-western end of Crookham Common, 1909




Figure 28: extract from the six inch third edition Ordnance Survey map to show the northern part of Greenham Common and the north-western end of Crookham Common, 1909




Figure 29: extract from the six inch third edition Ordnance Survey map to show part of the southern margins of Crookham Common, 1909






Figure 30: extract from the six inch third edition Ordnance Survey map to show the northern and eastern parts of Crookham Common, 1909




Figure 34: aerial photograph of the eastern end of the runway and technical site (looking north; RAF/106G/LA/60, Frame 3039, 29th November 1944)




Figure 35: aerial photograph looking north along the 1100 yard runway towards the bomb stores, dispersals and dispersed site No. 8 (RAF/106G/LA/60, Frame 4021, 29th November 1944)




Figure 36: aerial photograph of the bomb stores and dispersed sites Nos. 2 and 8 at the eastern end of the main runway (looking north; RAF/106G/LA/60, Frame 4020, 29th November 1944)




Figure 39: aerial photograph of glider assembly areas and crates on Crookham Common, between Thornford Gully and Boar's Gully (looking north; RAF/106G/LA/60, Frame 3043, 29^{th} November 1944)




Figure 42: extract from the revised edition Ordnance Survey map, 1972 to 1976 (not to scale)




Figure 47: aerial photograph of the runway cross and New Greenham Park (OS/98569, Frame 64, 16th May 1998)




Figure 48: aerial photograph of the runway cross and the eastern side of New Greenham Park (OS/98569, Frame 65, 16^{th} May 1998)
